February 28 – March 12	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>“Infrastructure Security” &amp; Basic Personal Defense Shooting / Personal Defense</b></p> <p>Infrastructure Security is a very current security issue. The seminar will discuss issues in physical and telecommunications infrastructure and cover topics such as threat and vulnerability analysis, risk evaluation, protection mechanisms, warning systems, routine and emergency procedures, technology, among others.</p> <p>The Personal Defense and awareness part will cover strategies, plans, and training to improve personal defense and provide Israeli martial arts classes.
